## 2008 AHP CANADA AWARDS

### 2008 Awards Categories:

#### ***Culture of Philanthropy Award*** (maximum 40 points)

This award will be presented to an organization that can demonstrate:

- Creative ways to raise awareness about philanthropy and its value to the organization. (1-10 points)
- Innovative and collaborative strategies to engage all stakeholders in philanthropy. (1-10 points)
- Evidence that people at all levels of the organization understand and are committed to fulfill their role in the development and philanthropic process, such as hospital staff including CEO, volunteers and development staff. (1-10 points)
- How these efforts have translated into a positive public profile and increased financial support for the organization's vision and mission. (1-10 points)

#### ***Outstanding Development Program*** (maximum 40 points)

This award will be presented to an organization that can demonstrate:

- Outstanding governance and leadership. (1-10 points)
- Donor-centred programs that help meet the community's needs. (1-10 points)
- Efficiency and effectiveness of philanthropic and fundraising initiatives. (1-10 points)
- Encouragement and motivation to staff and volunteers to take leadership roles in professional organizations and/or the community. (1-10 points)

#### ***Healthcare Fundraising Professional of the Year (2 awards)*** (maximum 40 points)

**Small Shop:** One or two full-time equivalent (FTE) staff

**Large Shop:** Three or more full-time equivalent (FTE) staff

Candidates must be an AHP Canada member in good standing. The nomination should include:

- Description of career achievements. Candidates must have at least five years of professional healthcare philanthropy experience. (1-10 points)
- Evidence of outstanding leadership, teamwork and innovation. (1-10 points)
- Information regarding financial results, stewardship and accountability (1-10 points)
- Details of candidate's commitment to ongoing professional development including certification (CFRE, FAHP), conference participation, publication and professional education. (1-10 points)

## AHP Canada Awards – 2008 Entry Form

## 2008 AHP CANADA AWARDS

### Eligibility

Entries are encouraged from all AHP members in good standing. Self-nominations are welcome. If nominating a colleague, please seek that person's permission prior to submission.

Nominations must be a maximum of 1,500 words of narrative covering the four bullet points associated with each category and must be accompanied by the completed AHP Awards Canada Nominations Form.

### Deadline

Nominations will be accepted until February 29<sup>th</sup>, 2008 at midnight.

Nominations may be submitted electronically but the entry fee must be received by the February 29<sup>th</sup>, 2008 deadline in order to be eligible for judging.

- Efficiency and effectiveness of philanthropic and fundraising initiatives. *(1-10 points)*
- Encouragement and motivation to staff and volunteers to take leadership roles in professional organizations and/or the community. *(1-10 points)*

#### ***Healthcare Fundraising Professional of the Year (2 awards) (maximum 40 points)***

**Small Shop:** One or two full-time equivalent (FTE) staff

**Large Shop:** Three or more full-time equivalent (FTE) staff

The nomination will be judged on:

- Career achievements - candidates must have at least five years of professional healthcare philanthropy experience. *(1-10 points)*
- Evidence of outstanding leadership, teamwork and innovation. *(1-10 points)*
- Information regarding financial results, stewardship and accountability *(1-10 points)*
- Details of candidate's commitment to ongoing professional development including certification (CFRE, FAHP), conference participation, publication and professional education. *(1-10 points)*

### **Judging**

A national team of judges, comprised of AHP members, will select the winners whose names will be announced at the AHP Canada Regional Conference in Halifax, Nova Scotia on Tuesday, April 15, 2008 in conjunction with the Health Care Public Relations Association (HCPRA) Hygeia Awards.

Judges can disqualify entries that fail to meet evaluation criteria, are missing an entry fee, are entered in the wrong category, or are incomplete.

Members of the selection team will not be involved in judging submissions from their own organization.

AHP Canada's Awards Chair and Judges' decisions are final.

### **Fees**

An entry fee of \$65 per entry must be received by the February 29<sup>th</sup>, 2008 deadline for entry to be eligible for judging. Cheques or money orders should be made payable to AHP Canada and are non-refundable.
